Registration will take place inside the front entrance, in St. George's narthex. Each bidding unit will receive a numbered paddle that will be used during the live auction. That number will also be used in the silent auction.

Bidding will begin at 5:30 PM in Hatlee Hall, the Library and the Narthex

Refreshments Include: Wine, a non-alcoholic punch, heavy hors d'oeuvres, and desserts

Childcare Available: St. George's Youth will provide childcare for a small fee. Pizza, drinks and cookies will be served. The children will enjoy movies and entertainment in Randles Hall. Please call the church office to make reservations for your children.

Live Auction: A Live Auction will be held at 7:00 PM. Items designated by the committee for the Live Auction will be sold to the highest bidder. Items for the Live Auction are described in this Auction Guide and have been available for evaluation on our web site. Minimum bids will be indicated for each item in the Auction Guide.

Silent Auction: The Silent Auction is held at designated tables where bidders record, in writing, increasingly higher bids. The highest bidder(s) receive(s) the item. Items are described, in advance, in this Auction Guide. Bidding closes at 7:00 PM. Payment may be made by cash or check to one of the cashiers and is due by the close of the event. In the case of multiple items being offered, the items will be awarded to the top ranking bidders.

Chinese Auction: The Chinese Auction continues until 8:00 PM. Color-coded tickets can be purchased from ticket sellers and deposited in bags marked to correspond with specific items on display (and described in this Auction Guide). At the conclusion of the Chinese Auction, the winning ticket number(s) will be announced. Winners claim the item, by showing the matching ticket. **The more tickets you deposit, the greater your opportunity to win!**
