Information Fact Sheet for St George's K-1 School

Art, Music, Drama experiences will be integrated into many learning experiences as well as taught as subjects.

Before and After-school programs are available beginning at 7:15 am going through 6 pm on each school day. A choice of age appropriate enrichment experiences will be offered under the guidance of qualified teachers. Pre-registration is required. For details, see the extended day description page.

Financial Aid: Applications for financial aid are available in the school office and will be sent out with acceptance letters.

Gym and physical education: Daily physical education experiences in a variety of settings: an expansive outdoor recreation area for sports and games, large indoor recreation space in Hatlee Hall.

Library and media services will be incorporated into the curriculum to support students' exploration of ideas and research skills. Until the media center is built, the library and computers will be available in each classroom. Teachers will incorporate age appropriate technology in instruction and learning.

Lunches and Snacks: students will bring lunch and snacks. Lunch will be held in Hatlee Hall where the Church kitchen is also located. Milk and other beverages can be refrigerated there.

Recess: Frequent outdoor exploration of the field and woodlands behind the school will be offered in addition to daily recess on the playground. Children will need to dress for the weather. An extra set of dry clothes will be kept in the students' cubbies for emergencies.

Report cards and other assessments: Sample report cards listing key skills and concepts to be mastered will be shared with families at beginning of school year.

School Day/ Year Calendar: St. George's School will follow the Shenendehowa School district daily schedule for on-campus elementary schools. (8:15 am to 2:15 pm) and follow their annual calendar.

School nurse: St George's School will have immediate access to the Shenendehowa campus elementary school nurses through telephone and scheduled visits to the St George's school. Students' medical records will be kept at both locations.

Technology skills will be integrated into the regular curriculum.

Transportation: Shenendehowa School District buses will transport students to St George's School for families living within 15 miles of the district. Proof of residency will be required. Parents who choose to transport their children will use a restricted safe entrance to the school for drop off and pick up.
